What you'll need:

- One empty plastic Disinfecting wipes container
 clean and dry
- Download Big Kahuna picture for the cover or your own design on paper
- Scissors
- Markers, crayons or colored pencils to decorate
- Clear plastic packing tape
- Plastic sheet protector or laminator

How to make it:

- 1. Remove the label on the disinfecting wipes container. Clean and dry it.
- 2. Download the pattern for the front of the container.
- 3. Measure the paper around the container and trim it to fit just below the rim with no excess hanging below the container. (Note: not all containers are the same diameter around so you may have to adjust the paper to fit properly.
- 4. Color in and decorate your picture.
- If you have a laminator, laminate your picture. If you do not have a laminator, you can use a plastic sheet protector cut to fit your design.
- 6. Attach your design to the container using the plastic packing tape.
- 7. For the top, you can leave it as is, or have an adult cut away the excess plastic area where the wipes feed through.

Now your big Kahuna will have a great place to stash his loot for a rainy day!
